



A Draft of a tract of land Situated in Hopewell township York County Pennsylvania Con-
taining altogether one hundred and fifty five acres seventy six perches and allowance.

The parts marked 'A' contain Respectively 106^{as} 72^{ps} and 2^{as} 102 perches being parts of a tract
of land of _____ originally surveyed on the fourth day of September 1765 for John Griffith. The
part marked 'B' containing 23^{as} 136^{ps} perches being part of a tract of land originally surveyed for Henry Schrack in pursuance of a
warrant for 40^{as} dated Sept. 30th 1774, Containing 33^{as} 29 perches & allowance. The parts marked
'C' being parts of a tract of 93^{as} 73 perches & allowance. Surveyed originally for James Griffith
on the 9th day of May 1794. in pursuance of two warrants dated Nov. 20th 1792.

Resurveyed the above on the 15th day of March 1864 for Andrew Fulton and Lydia Aikens
the present owners who wish to obtain a patent for the same.
