



Situate in Chanceford Township York County and Containing as Stated in the draught 390<sup>45</sup> 87 P's and allowance; of land originally surveyed in part by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 1<sup>st</sup> of March 1754 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> of February 1747, granted to Thomas Coulson for 100<sup>45</sup> which survey was afterwards on the 14<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> Mo. 1769 Completed by William Matthews late D.S. pursuant to an order of the board of property to that effect, dated the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1769: Resurveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1811. And now at the request of the heirs of John Musser deceased, who are the present owners, it is returned for Confirmation the twenty eighth day of May Anno domini 1811.
