Note Part mark'd **A** represents an interference with a survey in the ^{name} of Robert Iredell; The Part mark'd **B** represents the interference with a Survey made by virtue of an order of resurvey granted to Daniel Smith on warrant granted to James Parkinson Dated 21st Octr. 1784; and the Part mark'd **C** represents an interference with Frederick Fulmer's Survey on Warrant Dat- ed 13th June 1796.
