Returned in the Surveyor Generals Office of Pennsylvania, the 24th day of Augt 1857, which said return was not accepted in the Land Department, access too great, sent back to County Survey Office. Now be it known that the said Joel M. Grimm has taken out a new Warrant for the access, dated Augt 26th 1857.

Now I make return of the two tracts of land, mentioned in said Warrants to wit:

Twenty five acres of land & the allow. for roads &c. Surveyed as above said to Joel M. Grimm, on Warrant da 21st. Augt 1857

Ninety three acres & thirty eight perches & allow. of 6 per ct. Surveyd as abovesd. Warrant taken out for access. da Augt 26, 1857. Granted to Joel M. Grimm Containing Together, One hundred and eighteen Acres & thirty eight perches of land & the Usual allow. of 6 per Ct. for roads &c.
