



Draft of a Tract of land situated in Haines Township, Centre County, containing Seventy six acres and seventy six perches and Allowance of Six per cent. &c. Surveyed on the 24th<sup>th</sup> day November 1869, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Lewis Dorman on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 1868, for 70<sup>ac</sup> of land

Note The above draft contains 70<sup>ac</sup> and the addition of ten per cent - less 84 perches. It covers nearly all the ground occupied by two warrants, dated respectively April 9<sup>th</sup> 1867 for 50<sup>ac</sup> & June 24<sup>th</sup> 1868, for 33<sup>ac</sup> granted to Thomas W. Hosterman, returns of which have been to the Land Office by H. P. Treziulny former County Surveyor. As Mr. Dorman alleges gross injustice has been done him in the locating of the two Hosterman warrants, and in order to procure a decision of the Board of Property I have located Mr. Dorman's first warrant of June 6<sup>th</sup> 1868, upon the same ground, with the exception of a small strip on the mid-east side, the extreme North East end, and a small square on the north side of the tract (all of which is embraced by the lines dotted in red) in order to meet the requirements of Dorman's first warrant. The draft is also partly surrounded by a Diagram of Mr. Dorman's second warrant, as located upon the ground.
