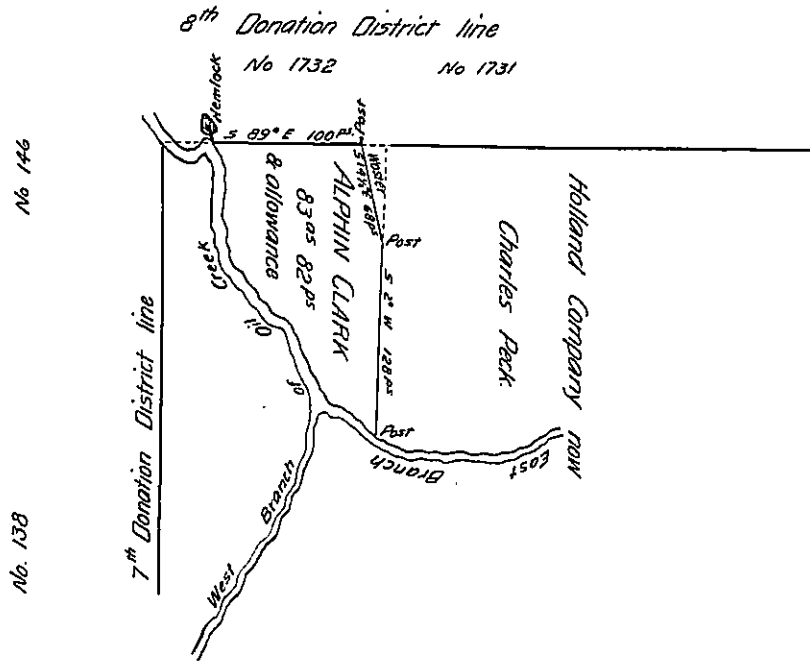


Courses of Oil Creek from

Situate on the West Branch of Oil Creek in Rome township Crawford County Containing Eighty three acres and eighty two perches & allowance of six p^t Cent for roads &c Surveyed November 26th A.D. 1847 for Alphin Clark being part of a larger tract of land that was settled and Improved by Nathan Winton agreeable to an act of the assembly and whereas the said Nathan Winton and Sarah his wife. By Deed dated the 5th day of May A. D. 1827 and Recorded in the office of said County in Deed Book II page 272 did convey the above described land to Gabriel Neuse, who conveyed the same to Joseph Neuse and Michael by Deed of trust dated June 3^d A. D. 1828 and Recorded in the Office of said County July 24th A. D. 1828. in Deed Book III page 67 who conveyed the same to Joseph G. Neuse by Deed dated the 26th day of August A. D. 1835 and Recorded in the office of said County January 11th A. D. 1836 in Deed Book IV page 572 From whom the same was sold at Sheriffs Sale, a Deed Poll acknowledged Feb. Term A. D. 1839 to Daniel Bennet (this record should have been Daniel Bement, who deeded the same to Alphin Clark By Deed dated the 3^d day of June A. D. 1839 and Recorded December 29th A. D. 1847 in Deed Book A No 2 pages 329 & 330
