Stevenson then D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>as</sup> granted to Peter Craver (alias Crever) bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December 1750. Since Resurveyed & divided & c. Now on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1839 Examined & Corrected the above & c. at the request of John Trimmer the present owner who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation
