S. under George Stevenson late D. S. in pursuance of a Warrant for 150^{ac} Granted to George Conrad bearing date the 6th day of April 1745 And since Resurveyed and Divided the said larger tract and parts returned and patented &c And on the 12th day of May 1866 the above was resurveyed by D. M. Ettinger &c And now on the 7th day of January 1867 having examined the above surveys and found the same correct and being Requested by Valentine Emig the present owner to Return the same for patenting &c.
