No 2135. The other for 250^a Dated the 14th day of January 1767. No. 2364. which larger tract appears to have been returned by the said William Mathews in dispute between a certain Hugh Nelson, James Hammond assignee of William Montgomery, and the Heirs of John Liggate deceased, as by a Copy of the Original draught under seal from the land office now filed in this office may appear— Re-surveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land the 6th of the 8th Month 1790 by William Kersey late D.S. for the present owner John Grove who desired me to make return of the above draught, as calculated, examined, and corrected the 2^d day of August A.D. 1809.
