



By Virtue of a warrant granted to George Harmon dated the 15th day of February A.D. 1800. Surveyed the 26th day of March A.D. 1838 unto John Young (the present owner of the three tracts) situate in Lehigh Township Northampton County Containing one hundred and thirty seven acres and one hundred and fifty perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. (It being improved land) Per A. W. Lerch D. S.
