



Draught of a tract of land belonging to James W. McCoy Situate in Quincy Township Franklin County Penna. Containing in the whole 87 acres and 158 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads etc. being part of two larger tracts of land Viz:- 54 acres and 153 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads etc. being part of a tract formerly surveyed for Daniel McCoy on a Warrant for 300 acres dated September 16th 1766- And 33 acres and 5 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. being part of a tract formerly surveyed for William Patrick on a Warrant for 50 acres dated August 24th 1743- Surveyed for James W. McCoy October 7th 1851.
