Situated on the waters of Russhy Run in Luzerne Township Fayette County and surveyed by request of Ellen Garwood, Charles Richards, Elizabeth Richards, Alice Richards and others, present owners and occupants of a Tract of Land situated as above and surveyed by Alexander McClain in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John McKim to take up 150 Acrs. of Land dated the 15th day of July 1773 and on account of an interference with the prior right of Thomas Gilpin resurveyed and corrected the same which appears on Record in the surveyers office of Fayette Co. said record contains a foot note saying this survey is wholly or principally controverted by James Hammond patent not to issue until the parties are heard by the Honorable Board of Property

And now March 27-30-1900 resurveyed the residue of the said Tract of Land and after satisfying all abutting surveys return for patent 98 Acres 44 perches and allowance of 6% for roads &c.
