



Now in Washington Township Franklin County

On the 28th March 1743 a warrant issued in favor of John Newcomer for 100 acres of land at or near Casper Walters land at Conococheague in the then county of Lancaster. And on 9th May 1765 representation was made to the then Secretary by George Koch setting forth that he the said George was then entitled to the benefit of said Warrant & that the land for which it was granted was held from him by prior Warrant & Patent. On account of all which the first said Warrant was directed to be executed on a vacant tract of 100 acres in Antrim township joining In^o Smith Adam Kock & Francis Urie to include the Improvement of the said George Koch & to be in lieu of the 100^o first mentioned in said Warrant. And in pursuance of said 2^d Order the Tract of land above represented appears to have been made by James Cunningham Esq^r as p^t his Draft & Calculation now remaining in this office & which is Dated 11th Jan^y 1766 nor is there any essential difference found between that survey & a resurvey made of the same on the 13th of April 1798
