



By Vertue of Five Different Warrants and one Application, As Follows — The First one Granting Fifty Four Acres and Eighty Six Perches And Allowances unto Henry Conferd on March 28th 1749— The Second one Granting Nine Acres and twenty Perches and allowances unto John George Gudekunst on April 28th 1775— The Third one Granting Sixteen Acres and Eighty Perches And Allowances unto Baltzer Fritz on January 2nd 1786.— The Fourth one Granting Six Acres and Eighty Seven Perches and Allowances, Being part of a larger Grant Granted unto John Baker on January 24th 1770— And the Fifth one Granted twenty Acres and one hundred and Eighteen Perches And Allowances Being Part of a larger Grant unto John Bare on June 9th 1747— And on Application No. 2588 Granting Fifteen Acres and Forty Five Perches and Allowances Being part of a larger Grant unto John George Gudekunst on May 11th 1767— Together Containing one hundred and twenty two Acres and one hundred and sixteen Perches An- Allowances of six per cent for Roads &c. All situated In the Township of Weisenburg County of Lehigh and State of Pennsylvania— Surveyed under 3 1/4 degrees variation From the Lehigh County Established Maredean Line on July 18th 1864.
