



A Draught of a survey called "Horse-Neck" situate on the waters of Raccoon Cr in Washington County cont^g 423 acs 34 ps strict measure executed Mc^h y^e 25th 1786 in consequence of a Certif^t for 400 acs granted to Tho^s Biggar by the Commiss^{rs} appointed by Virg^a to adjust the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties Monong^a Yohog^a & Ohio.

Note. Tho^s Biggar's Entry does not appear on the authenticated List transmitted to us from Phil^a; but Wm Crawford the Virginia Surveyor hath Certified on the back of y^e Commiss^{rs} Certif^t that the same was entered with him the 23^d of Feby 1780.
