We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Land in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that John Chapman Assignee of Thomas Clark is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land. Situate lying and Being in the County of Ohio on the Waters of Buffalo Creek to include an actual settlement made by the said Thomas Clark in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy three.

Given under our hands at Redstone ~~at~~ fort this sixteenth day of November 1779 and in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
