



Situated on the east side of Monongahela River near one Mile above the Old Fort in Luzerne Township Fayette County and surveyed the 14th Day of January 1785 in pursuance of an Order of Survey No. 615 Dated April 3^d 1769.

This survey I attempted to make in the year 1769 but was opposed by Robert Thorne who was then in possession. in the year 1770 it was again attempted by Moses McClean and in part executed but was prevented by Mr. Souke Collins who purchased from Thorne — it has been ever since in dispute & Shearer kept out of possession until September last when possession was awarded by a jury &c. the title not yet determined.
