



Situate formerly in Manchester now in peradin Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 257° 46' & allowance being part of a larger Tract of 548° & 22'. Originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D. S. in pursuance of two Warrants one granted to John Deenshaw for 100<sup>ac</sup> bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August 1750 the other granted to Jacob Stamm for 100<sup>ac</sup> bearing date the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1762 resurveyed and divided off from sd larger tract on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October 1804 and now after having been carefully examined corrected & calculated it is at the request of the present owner returned for confirmation the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August AD 1809
