



Situate in Town now Beach-Bottom Township in the County of York containing in the whole as above set forth 212^{ac} & 69 perches and the allowance the part marked A within the Red shaded lines contains 57^{ac} & 21 perches and the allowance being part of a larger tract of 122^{ac} & 74 perches and the allowance which was originally surveyed on the 29th Day of October AD 1744 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Bowles bearing date the 19th Day of June AD 1744. The part marked B within the Green shaded lines contains 39^{ac} & 17 perches and allowance which was originally surveyed by Jacob Spangler then D.D. on the 23rd Day of May AD 1810 in pursuance of a warrant for 35 ac. granted to Robert Ramsay bearing date the 15th Day of August 1809, & the part marked C within the Yellow shaded lines containing 116^{ac} & 31 perches and allowance being part of a larger tract of 178^{ac} and 21 perches and allowance which was originally surveyed to the heirs of Robert Taylor in pursuance of a warrant granted to Hugh Whiteford and John Taylor executors of the said Robert Taylor bearing date September 24th AD 1765. And on the 18th Day of August AD 1838 Resurveyed the exterior boundary or outside lines and reduced the whole into one entire Draft agreeably to the request of James Ramsay the present owner.
