



A Draught of one hundred and thirty acres & 143 perches of Land and the usual Allowance of six per Cent Situate in the Township of Heartck and County of Lancaster surveyed to James Read in pursuance of a Warrant dated the first Day of July AD. 1755 and Returned to the Surveyor General's Office of Pennsylvania, but by a late Survey thereof made it is found that where the two Lines intersect at the Corner Heartck this ~~is~~ and now fixed for a corner doth not exactly agree with the Courses and Distances of the same on the Original Return Oct<sup>r</sup> 26<sup>th</sup> 1808.
