


A draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of Upper Bern, and County of Berks, containing one hundred and eight Acres, ninety six Perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads &c. surveyed for William H. & Valentine H. Reentschler, William L. Key, George Rein- sel, and Salina C. Balthaser, the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1883. It embraces five tracts of land, two of which are 16<sup>ac</sup> 81<sup>pts</sup> originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant to Jacob Rosse, dated June 19<sup>th</sup> 1790; one in pursuance of a warrant, Conrad Reiff for 20<sup>ac</sup> 103<sup>pts</sup> dated March 24<sup>th</sup> 1752, and one to Conrad Reiff for 17<sup>ac</sup> 52<sup>pts</sup> 7<sup>pts</sup> dated February 20<sup>th</sup> 1744; and one on Application No. 2236, 49<sup>ac</sup> 90<sup>pts</sup> dated Dec. 29, 1766.
