Sir
I rec^d yours of the 21st December 1812 and agreeable to your request I have laid ~~see~~ the diagram of the adjoining tracts of land as well ~~as~~ those that interfere delineating the interference as those that only adjoin in order to show that there does not appear to be any interference of the adjoining tracts with that part returned on the order of resurvey to Foster Dupony in right of Dennis Bardeen dated January 4th 1815 - on examination of the plots of the adjoining tracts as laid down you will discover that the courses appear generally to agree tolerable well with the old lines but the mention of a line in some of the lines to have been very erroneous! But I presume that the will in diagram will afford the information requisite in order to enable the owner to obtain a patent of that part of the tract returned agreeable to the order of resurvey - except assurance of my respect & esteem
