

Situate in North Codorus Township York County.

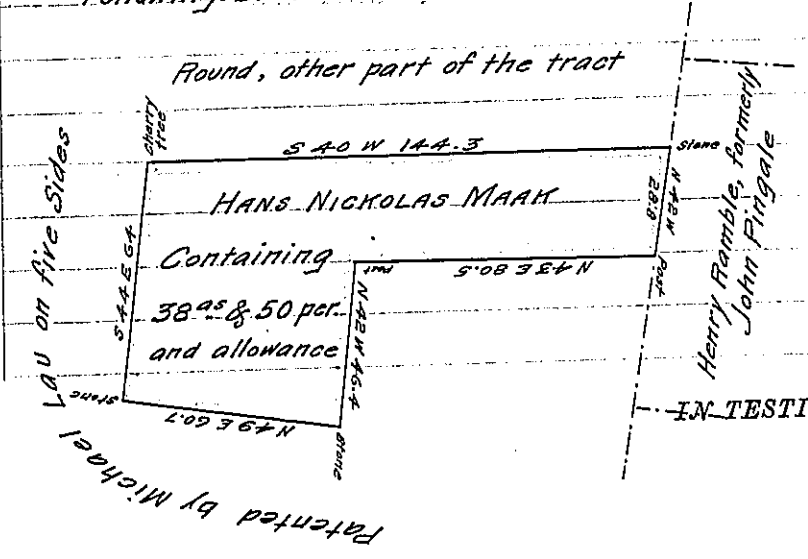
