



Draught of a Tract of land Situate in Great-Bend township Susquehanna County, Adjoining the Susquehanna River on the North — Lands Surveyed to N.C. Lewis, Jacob Peterman and Oliver Trowbridge on the South East, and lands of Seat and Westbrook, Wright Chamberlain and David Taylor on the North West. — Surveyed by John Boyle and myself on the Second day of February A.D. 1847. For Thos. R. Brayton and Cyrus J. Skinner, Which Survey is approved and adopted by me in pursuance of Cyrus J. Skinner's Warrant bearing date the twenty ninth day of September A. D. 1856. Containing Two hundred and ninety one acres and the allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. Also containing an improvement of about ten acres commenced about the first day of March A. D. 1842, With the Said Cyrus J. Skinner actually residing thereon.

Note — The records show that this Tract of land is covered by 3 Warrants, in the Name of Asa Stevens, Jonathan Stevens and Reuben Downing. The Stevens Warrants are represented to have been executed by O. S. Beber on the 15th & 16th days of May 1849. There is a Small piece adjoining the River, Containing Six acres — Marked thus X — that I believe there is no person claiming.
