Surveyed by Tho^s. Woodside then D.S. And Lot **A** N^o. 1 Situate as aforesaid and adjoining lands of Robert Jewell. Surveyed 4th April 1827 unto John Frederick Hower (in R^t of John Sprogell) by Virtue of his order of Resurvey dated 20th day of May 1794 containing 199 acres & 105 perches and allowance of Six Per Cent $\frac{8}{10}$.
