The above described tract of land Situate in Conemaugh Township Indiana County Containing two hundred and four Acres and sixty Eight perches and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Being parts of three adjoining Surveys as follows Viz., That part marked with the letter A Containing one hundred and forty five Acres and sixty Eight perches is a part of a larger tract of land Surveyed to Ephraim Steel in pursuance of a Warrant dated 10th day of April 1775 that part Marked with letter B Containing nine acres and one hundred and fifty two perches and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c was Surveyed to Samuel Marshall on Warrant dated the 17th day of January 1833 That part Marked with the letter C. Containing forty nine Acres and forty Eight perches and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c was Surveyed to the Said George Gilbert on the 27th day of January 1854 in pursuance of a Warrant dated 18th day of January A D 1854 bounded as above described
