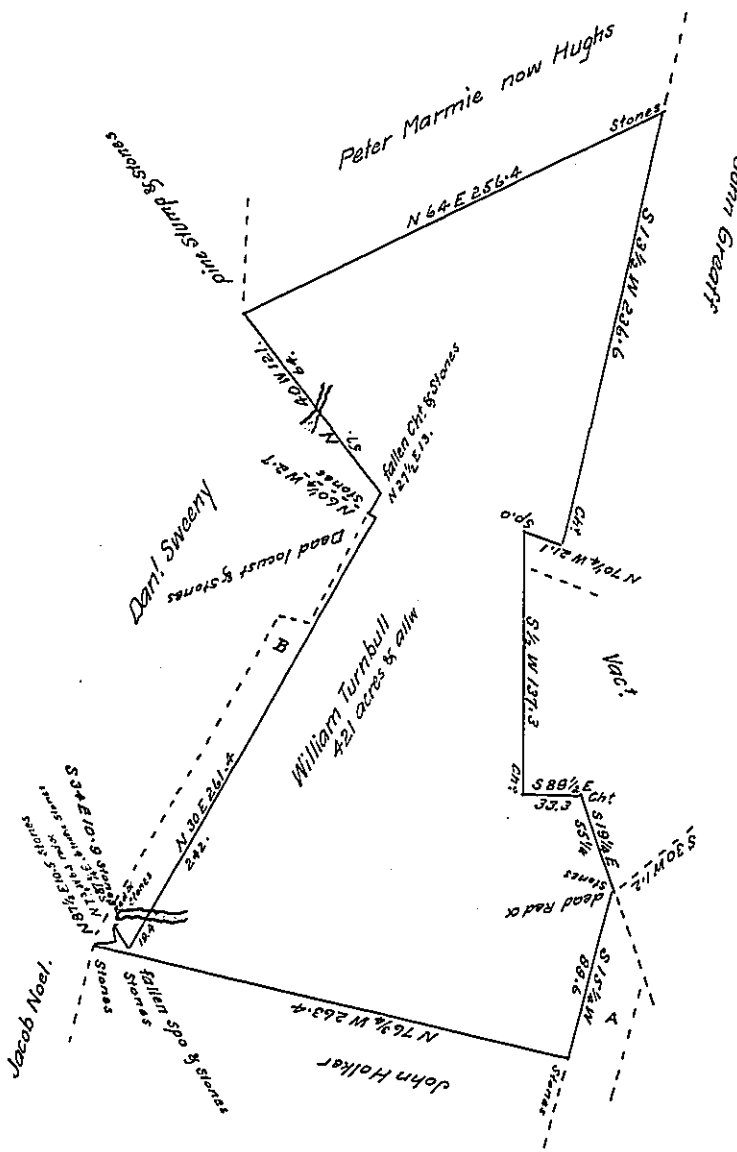


A Was an interference with land now owned by Alex<sup>r</sup> Russell Esq.
