



In pursuance of an Act of assembly passed March 17th 1820 authorising Jacob Spangler Thomas Smith and Robert Orr Jun. to make partition of the real estate of George Bryan Esq. late of the City of Phila. (deceased) And allot to each of his heirs their respective shares of said Estate, and agreeable to the report of the said Spangler, Smith and Orr from which a Diagram by them made and is entered on record in this County, appears that lot number six was allotted to and become the share of Sarah Bryan., Therefore and conformable to the foregoing, ~~being~~ Surveyed to Sarah Bryan on the 10th day of August 1825 the above described tract of Land containing two hundred and seventy four acres, Eighty four perches and the allowance of six P. Cent & C. it being lot number six, the south east end and one half of a larger tract, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Doct. William Smith dated October 20th 1785 and numbered 674, Situate adjoining lands of Samuel Wallace Esq. Bryan Esq. and others on the waters of Pine Creek Wayne Township Armstrong County
