



The lines Courses & distances of the above Draught, was Taken from the draught of Michael Moyers Land, & three old Loose papers brought from amongst John Taylors old papers Concerning the Proprietaries Manor of Comestoge, done in order to make return of Browpathers Survey for ~~Jacob~~ Peter Whitmore, in Pursuance of a Warrant dated ye 10<sup>th</sup> day of November 1763 Issued for the Acceptance of Jno<sup>e</sup> Taylors Survey, when in fact there was No regular Survey to be found of The same, And I gave it as my oppinion to the Secretary before the granting said Warrant that said Land ought to be resurveyed but Whitmore by some Means Obtained a Warrant to accept instead of Resurvey whereby I apprehend the Hon.<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries have Lost at Least seven acres of Land with Intrest & Quit Rent from the Year 1737.
