



In pursuance of a Warrant dated July 9th 1788 Granted to John Wells and John Rightley Surveyed on the 16th day of April 1790 containing four hundred and Eight acres and one fourth of an acre with the usual allowance of Six per cent. &c as appears from a Warrant and Survey Remaining on file in the Deputy Surveyors office of Armstrong County.

N.B. By whom the above Survey was made dose not appear from the draught but appears to be in the hand writing of Joshua Elder. he also says in a Note - That the Warrant by which this was surveyed had been intended for land adjoining William Patton James Donsath and others in Derry Township but was taken by an earlier Warrant. And now To Wit on the 17th day of September 1840 Resurveyed the above described Tract of land and find the lines all upon the ground to correspond with the above diagram and to contain four hundred and Eight ^{acres} and one fourth of an acre and allowance &c and that there dose not appear to be any interfering claim whatever. Situate now ⁱⁿ Kiskaminetas Township Armstrong County — To Jacob Sallade Esq^r Surveyor General. For Isaiah Guthrie D.S. I. E. Meredith
