



Situata in Manheim Township York County and Resurveyed by the Old Lines this 27th day of May 1790 for John Boyer
 In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Wilson the 27th day of January 1757 for 40^{ac} by Moses McClean Esq^r
 John Boyer who is the present Owner of Thomas Wilsons Tract as here laid down intending to Patent his Lands
 desired me when at Philadelphia in April last to examine whether a Return had been made, but finding none in
 the Office I procured a Copy of Wilsons Warrant and find on Resurveying the same that Thomas Armor who then
 Surveyed under Geo: Stephenson had run the dotted Lines including A and afterwards added that part as appears
 by Thomas Wilsons Poll Deed to Jacob Eiler dated the 20th day of October 1761 about seven Months before the date of
 Peter Gicklers Warrant and it appears that Levi Stephens who Surveyed for Archibald McClean on the 25th day of
 Novr. 1766 included the part A in Peter Gicklers Survey here Represented by the dotted Lines - Inclosed is
 Thomas Armors Draught by which it appears the Conveyances have been drawn...
 It is impossible to determine whether a Line had been run by Thomas Armor at B as it has been Barrens
 at that time and very little Timber to mark and same part is now cleared but so far as there had been Timber
 I blocked the Trees which were marked 33 or 34 years - I have been thus particular as I expect nothing less than
 a Decision of the Board will determine the Matter
