



On Surveying a small Vacancy at A adjoining the above Survey which was made by Levi Stephens for Archibald McClean Dep^y Surv^r I discovered that there was an Error which was Occasioned by Stephens leaving an open Line from B to C & consequently could not prove his work - which laid me under the necessity of Resurveying the whole of Anthony New (now Peter Sanbles) Tract when I found the Line called N 65 E 45 Ps to measure 55.3 Ps which accounts for the Error principally - the other Measurements & Courses with my Instrument I found as entered in the inside of the Lines on the Draught - Stephens Closing Line was Run by Archd McClean only so far as John Swartzbaugs Land joined & therefore he could not discover the Error - Peter Sanble wishes to Patent the small Vacancy of 3 e & 105 Ps with the other which at his request I have laid down it being barrens and so small that no person would take a Warrant for it - the Propriety of which I submit.
