



The above is a Connected Draft of four tracts of Land Containing 1599 Acres 107 perches and allowance. Resurveyed October 1816 for the Washington Academy in pursuance of an order from the Board of Property dated May the 21st 1813 to correct an Error in the first Survey and to ascertain whether the land was within the Depreciation Survey, Situate in Ohio Township Beaver County the Excess as represented within the dotted lines was included in the first Survey as is now thrown off to Robert Barnes Settler Viz. 103 Acres and seven perches, with allowance —
