The Black lines indicate part of a larger tract of 192 as 80 ps & allow Originally Surveyed by virtue of an application N. 4008, dated the 17th day of May 1769, surveyed the 26th day of Nov. 1798, to Michael Ehro now the property of John Zittelmoyer, Jac Lutz, Fr^s Sassaman Jacob Snyder & others Surveyed for them the 11th day of July 1870, & containing 151.95 77 ps and allowance.

I do hereby certify that I have made survey on the above tracts of land and have found an interference of those tracts of 41 as 03 ps and allow which is Patented to Michael Ohl as above stated, leaving a ballance on the Michael Ehro tract of 151.95 77 ps and allowance which is not patented
