Alexander Gardner conveyed his moiety to James Hunter who devised the whole tract to James Hunter the present owner -

N^o 2. Represented by the Lake colored lines is a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for James Sterling on Order N^o 1370 dated the 26th day of September 1766. This tract interferes one Hundred and two acres and one hundred and sixty one perches with the Charles Pettit survey. James Sterling conveyed to James Hunter who devised the same to James Hunter the present owner -

N^o 3. represented in part by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Mathew Potter on order N^o 1369 dated the 26th day of September 1766 - this tract interferes Twelve acres and fifty three perches with the Charles Pettit survey - Mathew Potter conveyed to James Hunter who devised the same to James Hunter the present owner -
