The above recited warrant was executed the 14<sup>th</sup> of April 1830 and returned 97 A. 32 P. as per draft in my office. This return was rejected because it interfered with the lands of C. S. Cox Esq. as the warrantee informs me, I have resurveyed the whole of the adjoining lands to wit Cox's & Margerumis in right of Miller & Hagerman and find the above tract vacant and clear of all claims except that of Peter Schmick the above warrantee, in whose survey the same was with other lands originally included. I have therefore resurveyed the same clear of interferences and now make return thereof at the request of Peter Schmick.
