N^o 1 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for James Sterling on order N^o 1370 dated the 26th day of September 1766. This tract interferes three acres with the Christian Snyder tract - James Sterling conveyed to James Hunter who devised the same to James Hunter the present owner. N^o 2 represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for William Kennedy on order N^o 1367 dated the 26th day of September 1766. this tract interferes thirty six Acres with the Christian Snyder survey - William Kenedy conveyed to James Hunter who devised the same to James Hunter the present owner. N^o 3 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for Mathew Potter on order N^o 1369 dated the 26th day of September 1766. This tract interferes Three Hundred thirty and one half acres with the Christian Snyder survey - Mathew Potter conveyed to James Hunter the present owner. N^o 4 represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Alexander Gardner & James Hunter on order N^o 229. dated the 26th day of September 1766. this tract interferes Eighty five acres and Eighty three perches with the Christian Snyder survey. Alexander Gardner conveyed to James Hunter who devised the same to James Hunter the present owner.
