



The above Draft describes a tract of Land in Juniatta township (formerly Aye) Originally Surveyd on an Order of Survey for 300^{ac} dated the 4th Feb^y 1767 N^o 2679 Granted to Amos Taylor and contained 318^{ac} 27^{ac} which on Resurvey now appears to contain 348^{ac} 92^{ac} and allowance; The part contained in the black Lines is a part of the said tract of Amos Taylor and is now the property of Martin Zeigler of York County at whose request it is Surveyd and retund in Order that he may get a Deed of Confirmation for the Same.
