



In pursuance of a warrant dated the 11th day of February A.D. 1831 Surveyd the ^{19th of February and} 5th day of March 1831 unto Benjamin Chew the Younger the within described tract of Land situate in Blackley Township in the County of Philadelphia, Containing One Acre and one hundred and forty one perches including an improvement which improvement has been made about 20 years. Beginning at a stake for a corner of Land lately surveyd to John Prentis on the south side of the Lancaster Turnpike Road thence along the south side of said Road S 78° E 3.3 P. to the N.W. corner of a Frame building thence by the same and by a board fence to the S.W. corner of the fence S 11 1/2° W 3.5 P. then by a board fence S 77° E 2.9 P. to the S.E. corner of said fence, then by a board fence N 11 1/2° E 1.8 P. to the S.E. corner of a frame house then S. 78° E. 15 links to a corner then N 11 1/2° E. 1.8 P. to a corner on the south side of the Lancaster Turnpike Road or high street continued then S. 78° E. 26 P. to low water mark of Scuykill River or to a line in said River to which wharfs may lawfully be extended, thence by the same down the River S. 12° W. 10.4 P. to the S.E. corner of a wharf lately erected by John Gardner now deceased, then along the south side of said wharf by Land lately Surveyd to John Prentis N. 78° W. 21.8 P. to a corner then by the same S 17° W 1 P. then by the same N 78° W. 2.8 P. to a stake for a corner then by the same N 18° W 3.8 P. to a stake for a corner, then by the same N 36° E 7.1 P. to a stake then by the same N 12° W 4 P. to the beginning.
