The shaded lines represent a survey made to William Fullerton on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May 1774. By warrant of the 23<sup>d</sup> of July 1773 is found to lie north of the purchase of 1768 and within the purchase of 1784 on Little Mahoning Creek in Mahoning Township Indiana County. The dotted lines represent surveys made under new purchase warrants the names dates & number whereof inserted in the drafts respectively. is accepted by Archibald Smitten & Thomas Colgan who claim under the titles of Robert Reynolds and James Ritchie. Ascertained in pursuance of the several acts of assembly directing the recovery of the principal & interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of Locations or other office titles issued from or under the proprietary Government and by authority from the Board of property.
