



The shaded lines represent a survey made to James ^{Hart} on the _____ day of _____ By warrant of the _____ of July 1773. Situate in Mahoning Township in the County of Indiana is found to lie north of the purchase of 1768 and within the purchase of 1784. The dotted lines in the above diagram represent the surveys made under the new purchase titles. The survey of James Hart includes the improvement of John Brody who claims under the title to Thomas Grant and Daniel Smith No. 5814. The above interference ascertained the 13th day of May 1828 in pursuance of the several acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of Locations or other Office titles issued from or under the proprietary Government and by authority from the Board of property.
