Draught of a tract of land situate in Milford Township Mifflin County containing Three hundred and Eighteen acres & 126 perches & the allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads &c. which was surveyed for John Gray in pursuance of the Proprietaries Warrant Dated the 8 Day of February 1755 and said to contain 242 Acres in Lack now Milford Township Cumberland formerly now Mifflin County. Resurveyed agreeable to the old Lines for John Gray [the heir at Law of John Gray Deceased] the 6th Day of February 1799. In pursuance of the judgement of the Board of Property and an Order from the Surv. Gen' Dated the 25th Day of Aprile 1796

Note the above Survey does not appear to Interfer with any other Surveys heretofore made. The Red Lines Bearing N 37 1/2 W 75 1/4 and S 57 1/2 W 315 Pz appear not to have been mark'd at the time the Survey was made therefore Run them agreeable to their Courses allowing 2 1/2 Degrees for Variation
