



The above is a draft of Smith's Island & bar in the river Delaware mentioned and annexed to Solebury Township Bucks County by the act of assembly passed the 25th of September 1786 (for distributing & annexing the jurisdiction of certain islands) containing ten acres & the allowance of six. Rent surveyed unto Thomas & John Smith sons & devisees of Thomas Smith dec'd who in his lifetime paid for its location fifteen pounds to Alex. James Dallas Esq. Secretary of State the 29th June 1791 in virtue of which I make the Return Certifying the same to be in their peaceable possession this 20th of November 1801 To Samuel Cochran Esquire Surveyor General
