William Hoptrins not Pat'd

The dotted lines represent the Draught of a tract of land Surveyed for William Hoptrins on order dated the 29th day of October 1766, No. 1734. This tract interferes two hundred and eighty & one fourth acres with the William McCune Survey. William Hoptrins conveyed to Michal Hillegass, who conveyed to James More, who devised the same to Thomas More, the present owner.
