



Situate on the South side of the Frankstown Branch of Juniatta in Frankstown Township Huntingdon County containing two hundred and thirty four acres and one hundred and twenty seven perches and allowance of six per Cent. Surveyed for John Freeman on Order No. 53 dated the 1st day of August 1766.

No. 1 represents part of the draught of a tract of land surveyed for John Keer & Thomas Weerns on Warrant dated the 8th day of October 1774, this tract interferes forty four acres and ninety four perches; with the John Freeman Thomas Weerns & John Keer who conveyed to John Gripe; who conveyed to Jacob Shively who conveyed to Henry Mogle, the present owner and to Mr. Hasle who devised his part to widow & heirs his widow married Dr. Baler who with the heirs of Hasle are the present owners. No. 2 represents the draught of a tract of land surveyed for Thomas Weerns on warrant dated the 29th day of March 1774. This tract interferes one hundred and eighty nine acres and thirty three perches with the John Freeman survey. Thomas Weerns conveyed to John Gripe who conveyed to Christian Yontz who devised the same to his widow and heirs the present owners. The widow married Henry Mogle who claims her interest in said land
