



A Draft of A Tract of land situate in the Great Cove in Air township Bedford County containing three hundred & twenty two & one fourth acres & allowance of six per cent for Roads & so Surveyed for John McClellan the 23th day of May 1767 on Order No 2807 dated the 17th day of February 1767.

No 1 represented by the broken lines is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for John McClellan the 27th day of May 1785. In pursuance of A Warrant dated the 11th day of May 1785. This tract interferes three hundred & twenty two & one fourth acres with the John McClellan tract. John McClellan obtained the aforesaid Order of Survey & afterwards obtained the aforesaid warrant & then conveyed to Samuel Beichtall who conveyed part thereof to Alexander Hunter the present owner. the residue thereof he conveyed to Samuel Beichtall, Jr, who devised the same to his heirs the present owners.
