



Situate on the head waters of Little Juniata in Antes Township Huntingdon County containing three hundred thirty one acres twenty four perches and allowance for Roads of Six Per Cent for roads &c first surveyed the 1st day of April, 1767, in pursuance of an Order of Survey granted to Charles Mc Gwire dated the 29th day of January 1767, No. 2623 (as appears by an old draught in my possession & by lines marked on the ground) And resurvey'd the 9th day of June 1818. In pursuance of the said order, being redirected by the Surveyor Genl to the late Dep't S. (Jno. Morrison) of this district with orders to execute it and make return of the survey.

The tracts in right of George Duffield, George Duffield Senr and George Ward which are included by the dotted lines & interfere with Charles Mc Gwire, were survey'd in Sep. 1785. In pursuance of Warrant dated the 28th day of Feb'y 1785
