



The part marked A. is an Interference of a Tract of 137 acres & allise surveyed on warrant to Jacob Hunsaire dated 1st March 1744 - Patented 11th October 1750 - situate in Manheim Town P. now owned by John Linert

Part B & C. is an Interference of a Tract of 53 1/4 acres & allise surveyed on warrt for 50 acs. to Jacob Huntsector (alias Hunsaire) dated 23d October 1749 - Patented to Henry Liner junr 9th April, 1788,

Part B is now owned by John Linert above named, and part C by Henry Boyers, Magdalena Boyers, and Michael Linert, Containing 11 acres & 123 ps, all situate in Manheim Township. Witness my hand November 17th, 1837.
