



A Draught of a tract of land situated in Dictionson Township Cumb<sup>d</sup>. County. Containing 116 as. 92 ps. and allowance, surveyed agreeably to the old lines marked on the Ground the 26th day of October A.D. 1842 on an application for 150 acres, granted the 2nd day of August 1766 to Moses or Joseph Carson, Numbered 700, which said Application is one of those contained in List No. 2 delivered to me by the Board of Property in pursuance of a contract with said Board, under the provisions of an Act of Assembly passed the 11th day of April A.D. 1825.

N.B. The dotted lines, (at the Eastern end of the Tract) represent a survey made on a Commonwealth warrant to A. ~~Joshua Snyder~~ Joshua Snyder for 15 as. dated the 5th day of July A.D. 1834 under which he now claims & holds the same, agreeably to the said dotted lines, the said survey on the Commth. Warrant being altogether included within the lines of the survey on the said application, as represented in the diagram & marked A.

The present owners and occupiers of the residue of the tract, are William Randolph, Michael Myers, David Glenn, Simon Yeats, — Slusher and others — the said Randolph occupying the ancient improvement
