



Draught of a tract of land situate in Letterkenny township, Franklin County, containing in all two hundred & two acres, one hundred thirty nine perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 7th October, 1829. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under Proprietary rights &c. And by virtue of an order of survey dated the 1st day of August 1766, No. 140 granted to Jonathan Coates for 200 acs "joining a surveyed line of William Bairds and the North Mountain in Letterkenny Township."

Report The above tract is covered by the following Office Rights to wit: The part marked A separated by the dotted line, containing 101 acres & allce. is wholly the same as a tract survey'd 11 April, 1786 on warrant to John Dies dated 16 November 1784, held by Martin Bechtel & John Bowmans heirs under said title. The part marked B, is included within the lines of a larger tract of 311 acs & al. survey'd 18 Oct'r, 1785 on warrant to Robert Mitchell dated 2 March 1785 claimed by Isaac Fiches & James Fiddle in dispute under said title. Note The black lines represent the balance of survey on Mitchell's Warrant. Note No evidence appears of the Application of Coates being executed on the land.
